**ANNOUNCEMENT and CALL for PAPERS**

The Mathematical Society of the Philippines Region VII (MSP Region VII) Chapter invites all mathematicians and mathematics educators to participate in its 2021 MSP Cebu Research Congress and Convention to be held on December 3 and 10, 2021 via Zoom Platform with the theme "*Mathematics Research: Thriving Amid the Pandemic*".

The 2021 MSP Cebu Research Congress and Convention will feature plenary talks on mathematics and mathematics education. Researchers and educators in all areas of mathematics, mathematics education, computing and statistics are invited to contribute short papers for oral and poster presentation during the convention.

**Plenary Talks:**

The following have been invited to give 45-minute plenary talks: **Dr. Jose Ernie Lope** (President, Mathematical Society of the Philippines), **Dr. Istvan Mezo** (Research Professor, Nanjing University of Information Science and Technology, Nanjing, China), **Dr. Renier Mendoza** (Institute of Mathematics, University of the Philippines Diliman, Quezon City, Philippines) and **Dr. Enriqueta Reston** (Science Mathematics Education Department, University of San Carlos, Cebu City).

**Contributed Talks and Poster Presentations:**

Short paper presentations (10-15 minutes) will take place in at least four parallel sessions: (1) algebra, (2) graph theory and combinatorics, (3) analysis and applied mathematics, (4) math education and statistics. There will likewise be poster presentations on mathematics education and any of the topics given above.
