advancements in the field of healthcare. It aimed to shed new light on the divide between the two generations and how we, as advocates for equal care, can use our resources and technology to propel gerontologic care into a more equitable future.

Advancing Gerontologic Research in the Modern Setting

As the current generation easily embraces the advances in modern technology, the older population will undoubtedly get left behind in some ways. A digital divide between two different generations is inevitable as information is always expanding. For the older nonulation one cannot expect that they would retain the same level of uptake when compared to the younger nonulation. This trend was observed especially during the plight of the COVID-19 pandemic when thousands of



Filipino older adults were tested to the limits of social isolation

The team of Ragay, et al., CNU-CNAHS's faculty and team of professional researchers, further explored the phenomenon through their research.

Their study showed that prolonged periods of isolation and social restriction have put the population of older adults under increased stress. Most notably though, their study revealed that the significant disconnect of the older adults to their loved ones during the start of the guarantines was likely due to them having a lower affinity to new and emerging technologies.

However, this did not mean that the older adults were incapable of adapting to the modern setting. With proper guidance, they too can become adept at using relatively common technologies such as online social platforms (e.g., Skype, Facebook) and virtual meeting platforms (e.g., Google Meet, Zoom).

Alforque, et al., CNU-CNAHS's faculty and second team of professional researchers, expounded on this subject during the presentation of their research paper.

Ithough older adults may have additional difficulties when it comes to traversing the new digital world. iey can still learn to utilize new technologies to their advantage. By establishing policies and practices at advocate for equitable and inclusive access to technology, they may even become at par with the ew generation in terms of technological proficiency.

reating a New Generation of Care

I the current age, it has now become apparent that longevity is a standard; more individuals are now eaching ages beyond 70 and are enjoying their relatively long lives. New medical technology and ccurate diagnostics have now effectively reduced mortality rates of diseases and improved the quality f healthcare delivery. But then, one question comes to mind. With technological advancements finding

their place in the field of healthcare, will human nurses still be relevant in the future?



"Technology permeates every aspect of human life, particularly in nursing," he says. Although technology is here to stay, it can never replace the human aspect of nursing care



dditionally, it should always be taken into mind that technology is only there to guide the practice of ursing. It exists to augment the quality of care provided by nurses, not to replace them.

The idea of preparing human purses to be able to adapt and adopt to the future demands of human care ill always involve technology," he says. And as end users, we have the responsibility to become competent and proactive users" of such technologies.

e further stresses the importance of effective education in ensuring technological literacy and ompetency among student nurses. Dynamic and adept styles of teaching should be implemented by ducators to facilitate learning among student nurses. Technology should be appropriated into urriculums and learning methods so that students can learn to understand the importance of echnological competency in preserving the "humanness" of modern healthcare.




