Delivery of the Goods is required at the time and date specified in the Call-off, which may be to single or multiple destinations or multiple performances at multiple locations. Bidders should have completed, within Two (2) Years from the date of submission and receipt of bids, a contract similar to the Project. The description of an eligible bidder is contained in the Bidding Documents, particularly, in Section II (Instructions to Bidders).

3. Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using a non-discretionary "pass/fail" criterion as specified in the 2016 revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (RA) No. 9184.

Bidding is restricted to Filipino citizens/sole proprietorships, partnerships, or organizations with at least sixty percent (60%) interest or outstanding capital stock belonging to citizens of the Philippines, and to citizens or organizations of a country the laws or regulations of which grant similar rights or privileges to Filipino citizens, pursuant to RA No. 5183.

- 4. Prospective Bidders may obtain further information from Cebu Normal University and inspect the Bidding Documents at the address given below during office hours at 8:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M.
- 5. A complete set of Bidding Documents may be acquired by interested Bidders on May 31 June 19, 2024 from the given address and website(s) below and upon payment of the applicable fee for the Bidding Documents, pursuant to the latest Guidelines issued by the GPPB in the amount of Five Hundred Pesos (P 500.00); The Procuring Entity shall allow the bidder to present its proof of payment for the fees if it will be presented in person, by facsimile, or through electronic means.
- 6. The Cebu Normal University will hold a Pre-Bid Conference on June 7, 2024, 2:30 P.M. at the BAC Office, Room 203 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor, Administration Building, Cebu Normal University, Osmeña Boulevard, Cebu City, which shall be open to prospective bidders.
- 7. Bids must be duly received by the BAC Secretariat through manual submission at the BAC Office, Room 203 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor Administration Building, Cebu Normal University, Osmeña Boulevard, Cebu City on or before 1:00 P.M. of June 19, 2024. Late bids shall not be accepted.
- 8. All Bids must be accompanied by a bid security in any of the acceptable forms and in the amount stated in ITB Clause 14.

- 9. Bid opening shall be on *June 19*, 2024, 2:30 P.M. at the BAC Office, Room 203 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor, Administration Building, Cebu Normal University, Osmeña Boulevard, Cebu City. Bids will be opened in the presence of the bidders' representatives who choose to attend the activity.

The Cebu Normal University reserves the right to reject any and all bids, declare a failure of bidding, or not award the contract at any time prior to contract award in accordance with Sections 35.6 and 41 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders.
